

# **2016 Fundraising Accomplishments**



- -The parish reached our 2016 fundraising goal of \$100,000! Thanks be to God!
- -We had almost 100% parish participation
  - which is outstanding! Thank you to everyone for your giving.

# **2017 Fundraising Goals**



-We are announcing a new \$75K matching grant for 2017 with the goal of raising a total of \$150K by Nativity 2017.

-This will give us a total of \$250K by the end of the year to put toward our own church building!

-While our goal is 50% higher than last year, we have more than double the time to reach it.

-We already have \$5K pledged against our 2017 goal, which means we've already raised \$10K of \$150K in the first month.



# **Liturgical Music Ministry**



- Choir sings between 135 and 140 services per year.
- 2016 marked by growth in choir personnel from 13 to 19 members.
- Plans, Needs and Challenges for 2017:
  - More men's voices (tenors and basses) needed
  - Assistant and substitute directors need to be trained
  - More consistent participation in all services (not just Sunday Liturgies)
  - Installation of reflective panels above choir area to improve acoustics
  - Search continues for Children's Choir director

# Sisterhood Report



#### **Spiritual growth and development:**

- Participation in the Liturgical and Sacramental life of St. Katherine's
- Reading group meetings met four times

#### **Service - hospitality and care:**

- Sunday Agape meals (trapeza) all sisters (M. Elizabeth)
- Mid-week Holidays, after Liturgy meals all sisters (Vicki)
- Parish Holiday, St. Katherine day, celebratory meal all sisters (Katerina, Irina)
- Archbishop Benjamin visit, Mission's five year anniversary, reception and celebration – all sisters, with Brotherhood
- Series of Kulichi cooking classes Elena Borowski
- Meals delivery to new mothers all sisters
- Organizing post-Baptism receptions all sisters
- Church adornment (flowers, vestment change) with Brotherhood
- Church cleaning with Brotherhood (and more volunteers are needed!)

#### **2016 Goals**

- ✓ Quarterly high profile lecture series
- ✓ Distribute church information to local organizations (e.g., hospitals, nursing homes, funeral homes, breweries)
- ✓ Provide literature for both Orthodox and non-Orthodox visitors
- ✓ Provide lunch to immediate neighbors (i.e., businesses in this complex)
- ✓ Equip parishioner with tools to spread the Gospel to people we know
- ✓ Invite people to pan-orthodox events (water blessing, walk-for life, St Katherine College)

#### **2016 Accomplishments & Activities**

- Constructed an area to display literature for newcomers to our church.
- Advertised and promoted Pan-Orthodox events throughout the year.
- Funded and created an official Church sign, so that our parish is more visible.

#### **2017 Objectives**

- Develop and distribute tools to help parishioners spread the Gospel.
- Start a program to distribute lunches to the businesses in our complex once a month.
- Construct materials to distribute to local organizations in San Diego.
- Plan a relevant lecture for each quarter this year.
- Continue to advertise and promote pan-Orthodox events in the San Diego area.
