
THEOPHANY OF OUR LORD



GOD IS THE LORD

Deacon: In the First Tone - God is the Lord and has revealed Himself to us. Blessed is He that comes in the name of the Lord. O give thanks to the Lord, for He is good; for His mercy endures forever.



Deacon: All nations surrounded me; in the name of the Lord I cut them off.
